	<p>A list of people groups such as in Appendix I is of much greater value when viewed in conjunction with the institutions and geographic locations found in Appendix II, with the Facts and Consequences found in Appendix III, as well as in the context of the whole paper.</p>	
	<p>Digging deep into the harsh reality of the garden of suffering is necessary to identify some of the main causes of grief within Nursing, and the consequences on Nursing.</p>	
	<p>To separate and deal with 'Dirty clothes and stained linen' and to prepare for a clean start requires the construction of perspectives, a Nurse's emotions are involved more than ethical values and the principles of asepsis.</p>	
	<p>This exercise involves uncertainties – will the dirt wash out? Does the stain need a stain remover? Which stain remover will damage the fabric or make holes? Will I get AIDS? How can the stains be removed and the life of the fabric (Nursing) be preserved?</p>	
	<p>Painful analysis of the consequences in Nursing makes it possible to walk through the garden of suffering with Nurses in order to find directions to the garden of fragrance in Nursing</p>	
	<p>When placed into appendices this information became a tool of construction rather than a bone of contention. What is – is – with no recrimination. What has happened has now to be managed with a different kind of wisdom, sensitivity and understanding.</p>
